Living Streets is the UK charity for everyday walking and the people behind the walk to school campaign. We're proud to run one of the UK's leading behaviour-change initiatives: WOW – the year-round walk to school challenge. Your school has chosen to take part and we're excited to welcome you on board!

WOW is a pupil-led initiative where children record how they get to school every day. If they travel sustainably (walk, cycle, scoot or Park and Stride) at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge. It's that easy!

Walking to school and running WOW safely during COVID-19

The government is actively encouraging families to walk to school whenever they can at this time. However, it is important that measures in place to protect everyone's health are always observed. For this reason, we are committed to helping you adapt to changing circumstances, ensuring that everyone involved in our walk to school initiative stays safe. - WOW poster – let others know you're a WOW school!

For class teachers:

- 25 handy classroom guides with simple steps to running WOW.

Please note that your badges were initially packaged for use in summer 2020 and should now be awarded as follows: September – **X-ray**, October – **Zebra crossing**, November – **Microchip**, December – **Internet**. From January, the new theme will be Wonders of the World, with six brand-new badge designs.
